## Description of activities and learning outcomes

### ACTIVITY 1: [Introduction to the Study Visit]

First of all there has been the introduction to the project and to the Cultural Association Europolitiche by the President Antonio De Chiara; then there has been a short informal presentation by the participants. The second part of the morning has been dedicated to the presentation of the Erasmus Programme and the Epale Platform, Salto-Youth Participation Platform and other source of information by the Erasmus Ambassador Giusy Rossi. From 11h to 12h we had a remote lecture by Doctor Mario Leone, President of the Institute Altiero Spinelli of Ventotene about the history of the European Institutions and the model proposed by the federalist movement.

The learning methods and approaches we have applied have been non formal learning methods and the tasks for the participants were to fill in a questionnaire as a game, as a quiz with title "Who wants to be European?" in order to evaluate the basic knowledge about the European Policies, as a starting point for the discussion.

The planned learning outcomes for the participants during this activity in terms of new or improved knowledge, skills and competences are connected to European civic education, basic skills about European Policies, the Erasmus Program and other sources of information useful as a citizen.

### ACTIVITY 2: [Round Table about Media Literacy and risks for democracy]

The round table has been very interactive. The speakers were Giusy Rossi, Coordinator of the project, Alexandre Godonaise, President of the Association Les Jeunes Européens Strasbourg and Mylène Ober, Coordinator for the Erasmus Projects of the NGO Association Amsed active in the field of North South Cooperation with a special attention to the Mediterranean Area.

The learning methods and approaches that we applied where an informal talk first of all about the role and the activities of their own organisations then the discussion has been much more oriented to the current issues of the actual debate about the policy of the European Union, media literacy education, the risks for democracy in the era of the artificial intelligence, the tasks that participants have completed has been to take part in the discussion in english.

[The planned learning outcomes for the participants during this activity in terms of new or improved knowledge, skills and competences where to get to know some best practices about media literacy education and exercise their practice in a foreign language.]

### ACTIVITY 3: [Guided tour to the European Institutions and Study Visit to the European Parliament ]

The first activity was a promenade, a guided cultural tour about the European Institutions in the city of Strasbourg, conducted by Alexandre Godonaise President of the Association Les Jeunes Européens Strasbourg, in which we stopped in the most important parts of the city from the historical and cultural point of view. The second part of the morning has been dedicated to the guided visit to the Plenary Assembly of the European Parliament, with a guided tour.

The learning methods and approaches applied are related to non formal learning methods and following for participants

the history of the city discovering the most important elements such the discourse of Churchill in the square Kleber, or the restaurant where is born the Crocodile club funded by Altiero Spinelli and finally the main building of the Council of Europe. The most important part has been the Study Visit to the building of the European Parliament with a guided visit about the rules and the decision process of the Assembly, with active participation to the Plenary. We assisted to the debate about the autonomy of medicament for the European Union after the pandemic with the presence of the Commissioner to Health.

The planned learning outcomes for the participants was to learn during this activity an orientation in the city of Strasbourg and their European Institutions from the historical point of view, with non formal learning methods and to get familiar with the European Institutions such as the Parliament.

#### **ACTIVITY 4: [Meeting with the Parliamentarians and to the Mediathek Frida Khalo]**

In the afternoon, after the official introduction of the guided tour, we had the opportunity to meeting directly two MEPs: Dario Nardella (S&D) and Sandro Gozi (Renew Europe) and to have an interview with them about the current topics of the Agenda of the European Parliament, such peace and common defense, social cohesion, the role of the Erasmus Generation. The learning methods and approaches applied for participants has been an informal talk of 30 minutes duration each meeting, questions and answers session. After this meeting we visited the Madiathek Frida Khalo, a public service as a modern library, well known as a good practice in terms of media literacy education, run by the Eurometropole of Strasbourg.

The planned learning outcomes for the participants during this activity in terms of new or improved knowledge, skills and competences are the familiarization with the decision process of the European Parliament and the current policies in the Agenda. To get to know the good practice in terms of media literacy education with the project of the Mediathek, very active with participation of citizens and developing project of digital transition and free access to culture.

#### **ACTIVITY 5: [Study Visit to the Council of Europe and to the channel television Arte.tv]**

The guided visit has been an introduction to the history of the intergovernmental institution and its main roles about human rights. After the presentation in the plenary Assembly we have had the pleasure to meeting the Head of Communication for the Commissioner of Human Rights, Stefano Montanari, that has presented the risks for the journalists and the risks for cultural pluralism and democracy in different countries. He has in particular underlined the role of observatory by the Council of Europe and the importance of the respect of the rule of law in the 46 countries. The approach applied has been a lecture and the participants took part very actively asking questions about the situation in Italy. After the Council of Europe we visited the European channel Arte.tv available in six languages and also in Italian. Martina Magri in charge for the contents of the Italian platform has presented a show case about the documentaries, the series and the current challenges to be a European web platform.

The learning outcomes for the participants during this activity have been to get familiar with the Council of Europe and the Court of Human Rights, the values of freedom of expressions and the role of journalists. The visit to the television has been the opportunity of learning about the challenge to communicate European matters in different languages for a wide and multicultural audience.

#### **ACTIVITY 6: [Round Table about media freedom, youth participation and active citizenship]**

This activity has been a Round Table at the European Youth Centre Strasbourg of the Council of Europe where we discussed with two experts about media freedom, youth democracy and active participation oriented to the engagement of young people. The two expert guided the presentation of some good practices and projects of communication such as "Journalism matters", the "Hate of speech campaign" and the process of Revision of the European Charter of local and regional youth participation.

The learning outcomes for the participants during this activity in terms of new or improved knowledge, skills and competences were to get to know more about youth policy and media education, starting from the perspective of the human rights of the Council of Europe.

#### **ACTIVITY 7: [Final evaluation and learning outcomes]**

The final session has been concentrated to the learning outcomes and the final evaluation of the activities of the full Study Visit with a final questionnaire and an informal talk about the learning methods and approaches adopted in the different

sessions. The participants really appreciated the experience, the first Erasmus for the majority of the them.

The planned learning outcomes for the participants during this activity in terms of new or improved knowledge, skills and competences were a general reflection about the results of the Study Visit in particular from the point of view of media literacy education, active citizenship and familiarize with the European Institutions in Strasbourg.

#### ACTIVITY 8: [Free afternoon, guided tour by boat]

We have finished the final day of the Study Visit with a free afternoon, with a suggestion of an optional guided tour of the city by boat very much appreciated by who choose to participate.

The learning outcomes were to get to know better the city of Strasbourg from the perspective of the canals, very typical.
