INFORMATION ABOUT THE PROJECT:

This 16 days long voluntary camp with 30 international volunteers was organised by Egyesek Youth Association with the aim of fostering intercultural learning experience by living and working together in the busy community center called Creative Space. Our volunteers were preparing and delivering creative and innovative educational workshops for local children and youth to settlements in Nógrád county, one of the most disadvantaged areas of Hungary. During the camp the volunteers had the unique chance to understand and practice cooperation in both small and big group settings, to take responsibility for the volunteering and learning experience.

THE TASKS OF FRANCESCO CASTIGLIONE IN THE PROJECT:

Together with a team of volunteers, the participant developed and implemented creative workshops in English, following the principals of non-formal education, for children and youth living in small, isolated communities in rural Hungary.
