Within Erasmus+, a training course is a project where youth workers and youth leaders come together for several days to develop their knowledge, skills, and attitudes on a certain theme. The daily programme of the course is based on learning objectives and facilitated by experienced trainers. The training courses promote the initiative and creativity of participants and have a direct impact on their future youth work or youth policy activities, such as organising quality projects and providing intercultural and non-formal learning experiences for young people.

Altogether, **28** people from **Czech Republic, Estonia, France, Greece, Hungary, Italy, Lithuania, Portugal, Slovenia, and Spain** took part in the project.

The overall aim and specific objectives of the project:

The Power of Story Telling is a training course that aims at making youth workers and trainers aware of the many and various uses of the non-formal educational methods of storytelling and shows them how it can be used to work with young people and volunteers. Particularly the competences gained will help them addressing the topics of online hate speeches.

To explore the concept of "transformational storytelling" using storytelling as an innovative tool to address personal development;

Main contents and activities of the project:

The project included a wide range of non-formal education methods such as simulations, role plays, teambuilding, group work, ice-breaking, trust games, creative writing, reflective and self assessment methods.

Among the results of the project are the following:

The project resulted in a training of 28 youth workers on methods of storytelling and shows them how it can be used to work with young people and volunteers. Participants created local action plans based on Community Organising method. Booklet was created with activities and methods described.
